Adult Player Code of Conduct



Purpose

This code of conduct sets out the behaviour expected from all adult players at Sutton United Football Club to ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for everyone.

Player Expectations

Adult players are expected to:

- Attend training sessions, matches, and club activities on time and prepared
 - Follow instructions from coaches, staff, and officials
 - Demonstrate respect to teammates, opponents, referees, and spectators
 - Adhere to the rules of the game and play fairly
 - Maintain personal fitness and bring appropriate kit and equipment

Behaviour and Respect

Players must:

- Display good sportsmanship and integrity
 - Avoid abusive, offensive, or discriminatory language or actions
 - Accept decisions made by coaches, staff, and match officials without dispute
 - Support teammates and promote a positive team environment
 - Represent the club positively on and off the pitch

Health, Safety, and Welfare

- Follow health and safety instructions at all times
 - Report any injuries, hazards, or unsafe conditions immediately
 - Use club facilities and equipment responsibly

Social Media and Communication

- Use social media responsibly, respecting the privacy of others
 - Do not post content that is harmful, offensive, or damaging to the club's reputation

Consequences of Misconduct

Failure to follow this code may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings
 - Suspension from training, matches, or club activities
 - Further disciplinary action in line with club policies
