Spectators & Carers Code of Conduct

Purpose

This code sets out the expected behaviour for all spectators, parents and carers at Sutton United Football Club to ensure a safe, respectful and enjoyable environment for players, staff, volunteers and other spectators.

Behaviour Expectations

Spectators and carers are expected to:

- Encourage and support all players in a positive manner
 - Respect decisions made by coaches, officials and staff
 - Avoid abusive, offensive or discriminatory language or behaviour
 - Refrain from interfering with training sessions or matches
 - Support fair play and good sportsmanship at all times

Respect and Inclusion

- Treat all players, coaches, staff, volunteers and other spectators with respect
 - Respect differences in age, ability, gender, ethnicity, religion and background
 - Do not engage in bullying, harassment or discriminatory behaviour

Health & Safety

- Follow all health and safety instructions given by staff or officials
 - Keep clear of playing areas unless specifically authorised
 - Report any hazards, injuries or unsafe behaviour to a member of staff

Use of Social Media & Photography

- Use social media responsibly; do not post content that could harm or embarrass players, staff or the club
 - Obtain consent before taking photos or videos of players, particularly minors
 - Respect the privacy of players and families

Consequences

Failure to follow this code of conduct may result in:

- Being asked to leave training or matches
 - Temporary or permanent restriction from attending club activities
 - Further action in line with club policies
